

FAQs about the Fletcher Summer Institute for the Advanced Study of Nonviolent Conflict 2010 and its Application Process

What documents do I have to provide in order to apply?

In order to be considered for the program you will need to submit a completed application form which you can find on the ICNC website (www.nonviolent-conflict.org) and a copy of your CV.

Please note that incomplete applications will not be considered.
Only successful applicants will be notified.
Application deadline is March 1st, 2010.

I tried to submit my application online- but it didn't work!

If you have filled out the application form online, and your email software does not automatically generate an email when you hit the "submit" button, you need to save the completed application on your computer, and then attach it to an email, together with your updated CV.

Questions regarding program and faculty:

Program and faculty for FSI 2010 have yet to be finalized. This information will be made available as soon as possible. If you need this information in order to apply please get in touch with ICNC staff at fsi@nonviolent-conflict.org.

What are the registration fees for participants?

Registration fees are as follows:

- For corporations, government and media: \$500
- For international non-profit organizations and foundations: \$350
- For local or community based non-profit organizations: \$200
- For not institutionally affiliated activists and organizers: \$100

What does the fee cover?

The FSI participation fee covers administrative and communication costs. Meals and accommodations will be provided for all participants.
If you plan to arrive early or depart after the end of the program, you will be responsible for arranging and paying for those accommodations.

Travel and incidental expenses are not included and participants will be expected to cover these costs unless otherwise requested.

Questions regarding support for participation:

We understand that some applicants may have difficulty covering all costs associated with the program. Unfortunately we are not able to consider support on an individual basis until we have evaluated all applications.

Should your application be accepted, we will do our best to provide support to all who need it.

I am a student or professor – can I apply and what would the registration fee be?

FSI is intended primarily for NGO and international-institution policy staff, journalists, and other international-affairs professionals. However, we welcome applications from academics and university-affiliated researchers who are also writers, bloggers or activists. The fee that you would be assigned would be associated with your other affiliation or role.

Question concerning multiple individuals applying from the same organization:

Yes, we can accept more than one application from the same organization but we cannot guarantee that we will accept all applicants from the same organization.
